"The EFMC Prize for Young Medicinal Chemist in Industry" was initiated by the EFMC Industrial Liaison C to acknowledge and recognize an outstanding young medicinal chemist ( $\leq 35$  years old) working in industry Europe. The Prize is given annually and consists of a diploma, € 1.000 and an invitation for a short presentation at an EFMC symposium. Two runners-up will also be identified and acknowledged.

Nominations should be submitted by the candidate's supervisor and should consist of:

- a letter by the supervisor.
- a brief CV of the candidate.
- abstract of potential oral presentation.

"The EFMC Prize for Young Medicinal Chemist in Academia" was established by the European Federation of Medicinal Chemistry to acknowledge and recognize an outstanding young medicinal chemist ( $\leq 35$  years old) in academia within Europe. The Prize is given annually and consists of a diploma, € 1.000 and an invitation for a short presentation at an EFMC symposium. Two runners-up will also be identified and acknowledged.

Applications should consist of:

- a one-page letter by the candidate including a short rationale for their application.
- one page with his/her 5 most important publications.
- a brief CV of the candidate.
- abstract of potential oral presentation.
